Q: Do I use the **Plaisted's Organic Yard Compost** only as a soil amendment?

A: Yes. Healthy fertile soil is a mixture of water, air, minerals and organic matter.

Q: Does this compost help improve sandy soil conditions?

A: Yes. Using **Plaisted's Organic Yard Compost** will improve the ability of the soil to retain water and nutrients needed for better growth.

Q: Can **Plaisted's Organic Yard Compost** improve clay soil?
